Most trademarks are words, designs, or a combination of words and a design. But trademarks can take many other forms. Sounds, scents, shapes and colors can also be trademarks.



Understanding the Difference Between a

Trademark and a Product Name

A Trademark is the brand name for the product of a particular person or company.

The Product Name is the generic word for all products of the same type.

For example:

BIG MAC® and **WHOPPER®** are brand names; **hamburger** is the generic or product name.

ADIDAS® and REEBOK® are brand names; sneakers or athletic shoes are generic or product names.

KLEENEX® and **PUFFS®** are brand names; **facial tissue** is the generic or product name.

BASKIN-ROBBINS® and **BEN & JERRY"S®** are brand names; **ice cream store services** is the generic name of the service.
