
The undersigned family members of Jacob "Jake" Evans, Jami Evans and Mallory Evans appreciate the state's plea bargain offer of 45 years on two counts of murder, to run concurrently, as the disposition of this case. We feel that this is a fair plea bargain under all circumstances even though our family would support a lesser sentence than 45 years if it was possible to do so in this case. The family realizes that Jake will have to serve at least half of the assessed time before he becomes eligible for parole. We are unanimous in our support of Jake's decision to plead guilty and be assessed 45 years by the judge, rather than have a capital murder trial. None of us want Jake and our family to be subjected to a capital murder trial, which we feel would not be in his and our family's best interests. We wish to close this chapter of our lives in order to continue healing as a family.


