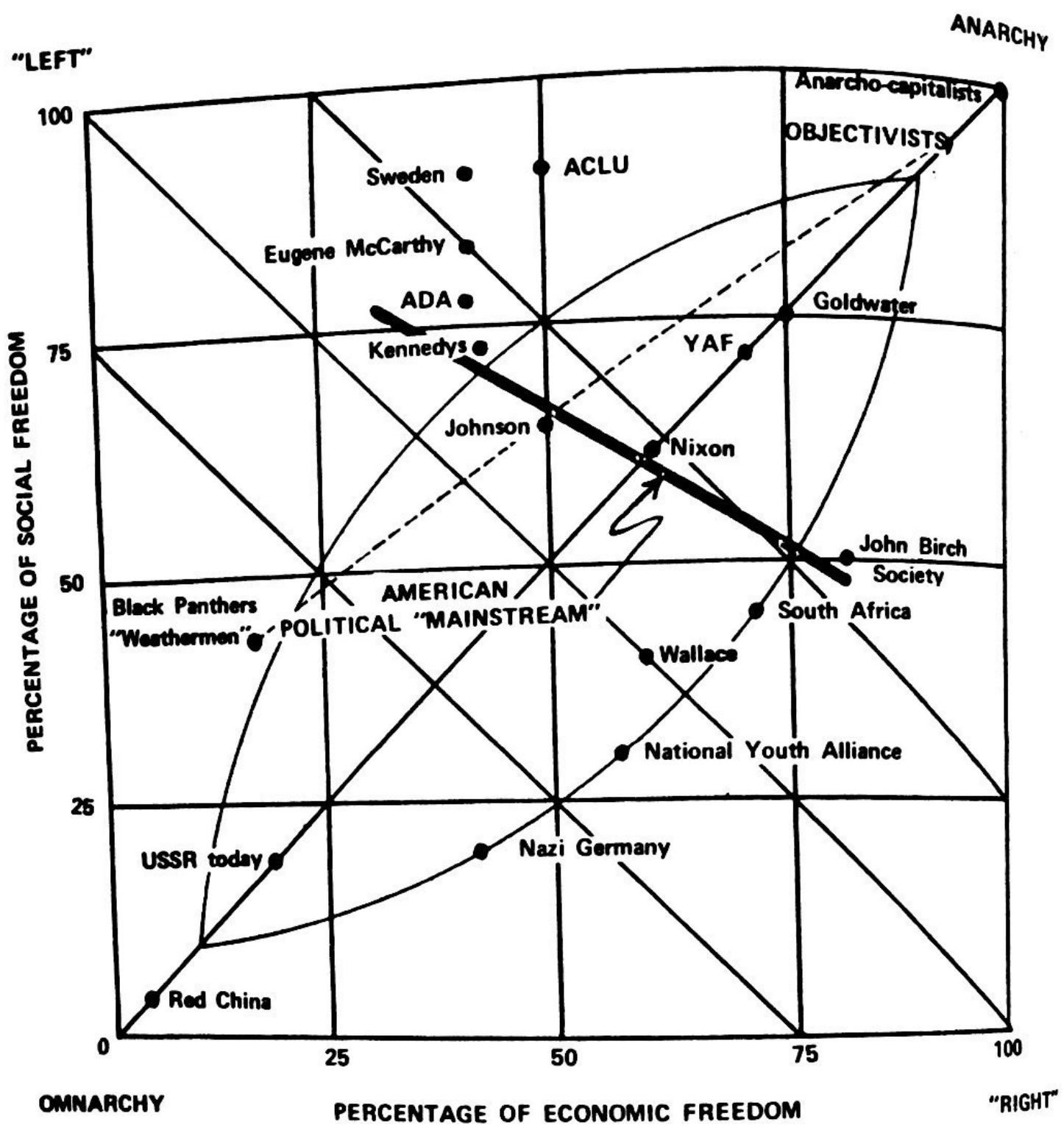

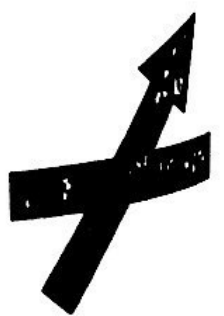
### F L A S H ! !
