Upon his graduation from M.I.T., Mr. Koch held a variety of engineering positions until becoming President of Abcor, Inc. in 1977 and President of Koch Engineering in 1978. Both companies design and fabricate pollution control equipment. Mr. Koch is a member of the Alumni Executive Committee of the Deerfield Academy in Deerfield, Massachusetts. A member of the Small College All-American Basketball team in 1962, he maintains an active interest in athletics.

Mr. Koch won the Libertarian Party Vice Presidential nomination on September 8, 1979, at the National Convention in Los Angeles, with 75% of the delegate vote.
