- 7) Do you oppose government licensing of doctors and lawyers? Wouldn't the public be victimized by quacks?

Economic

- 1) Some economists say that your proposal to stop inflation will do so--but will also cause a callapse in prices ~~and interest rates~~--a deflation--wiping out many homeowners and businessmen. Many outstanding mortgages and other loans were made with the expectation of continued high rates of inflation. How can you stop inflation without bankrupting many innocent debtors and causing a depression?
- 2) Your attacks on government regulation of the automobile industry suggest that all such regulation has been harmful and should be ended. What about pollution controls? Hasn't government regulation in this area helped clean up the air, and wouldn't an end to such regulation leave us all choking?
- 3) Your party platform says that "An employer should have the right to recognize, or refuse to recognize, a union..." This would require the repeal of the Wagner Act, and set unions back to their pre-1935 legal status. Do you support this plank?
- 4) The Libertarian platform says that "all criminal and civil sanctions against tax evasion should be terminated immediately." Do you agree?
- 5) Are you for prohibiting the construction of nuclear power plants, or for a moratorium on their construction?
- 6) Ending all tariffs and quotas will throw many innocent Americans out of work. Do you oppose giving them any government assistance to help them in their adjustment?

Foreign Policy

- 1) You have called conscription "slavery." Should soldiers already in the army, even volunteers, be allowed to quit at any time? If so, how can we expect the country to be defended?
- 2) You have implied that West Germany should spend more money on defense against the Soviet Union. Other countries in the region face a similar threat. Should Turkey, Greece, Yugoslavia, Sweden, or other countries near the Soviet Union increase their defense spending?
- 3) As president, would you use military force to defend Canada against an invasion by a foreign power? (If no, "Won't your public answer invite aggression?")
- 4) After closing foreign bases and abolishing the CIA, do you advocate stopping U.S. collection of intelligence with equipment based outside of U.S. territory?
- 5) If negotiations for three years of a Clark term failed to gain the release of the hostages in Teheran, would you persist in opposing any U.S. military action to gain their release?
- 6) If the Soviet Union launched a nuclear attack on the U.S., would you support retaliation with missiles targeted at Soviet population centers?
- 7) You have called the shah of Iran a "mass murderer." Because of the actions they supported in Iran, Vietnam, and elsewhere, are former presidents Kennedy, Johnson, Nixon, Ford, and president Carter also "mass murderers"?
